YEAR 10 PARENTS' EVENING, MONDAY 14th JANUARY 2019, 4pm – 7pm, ARTS CENTRE

On Monday 14th January you and your son/daughter are invited to a Year 10 subject parents' evening, giving you the opportunity to discuss your child's latest progress with their subject teachers. This will take place in the Arts Centre between 4pm and 7pm, with all subject teachers present. Our foyer coffee shop will be open for parents and students.

Subject parents' evenings are run on an appointment system. Appointments are at five-minute intervals at a time booked in advance by your child. There tends to be a greater demand for later appointments, so if you are able to come before 5pm it will be much appreciated. Please complete the attached sheet to indicate the teachers with whom you wish to make an appointment. Your child will need to bring this appointment sheet into school during the first week of school after the holidays up to and including the 14th January and approach their subject teachers to make the appointments. It is suggested that where possible a five minute gap is made between each appointment to allow for time to move from one teacher to another.

Year 10 is an important time as your child has been studying their GCSE courses for over a year now and this is approximately the half way point to Key Stage 4. We believe that parents, teachers and students can be a powerful team, working together towards the goal of great exam results. It is with this aim that you are warmly invited to the evening.

We are also taking the unusual step to speak to parents about the work experience programme for all Year 10 students. The work experience week is scheduled to take place from Monday 1st July to Friday 5th July 2019. During the subject parents' evening in January we will be giving a series of short presentations about work experience to introduce the aims and objectives of the week and give out packs of information for each student about the work experience programme. We would ask that you attend one of these 20 minute sessions at some point during the evening.
